

**C-GCC CARES Act Student Fund Application
Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF)**

Passed by Congress and signed into law, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act provides economic relief from COVID-19. One section of the CARES Act established the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) and sent money to colleges to use for emergency financial aid grants to students for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations because of the pandemic.

Degree-seeking students enrolled in Spring 2020, Summer 2020 and Fall 2020 who are eligible for Title IV federal financial aid are eligible to apply for CARES Act funds.

Funds are LIMITED and will restrict the number of recipients! Deadline: November 13, 2020.
