

Sexual Violence Prevention Report

In Spring 2019, the College administered a campus climate survey to students, faculty, and staff in an effort to gather information about the incidence of sexual violence and knowledge of the related policies and resources available on campus. The results of this survey will be used to further support the College's commitment to ensuring a safe, healthy, and nondiscriminatory environment for all students, faculty, and staff.

Results of the campus climate survey indicate that 83 percent of students, faculty, and staff are aware of the College's policies and procedures that specifically address sexual assault. Results of the survey also indicate that a majority of students, faculty, and staff know how to get help in the event of a sexual violence incident on campus.

The College will use the results of the campus climate survey to continuously improve and increase awareness of the College's sexual violence prevention policies and procedures.
